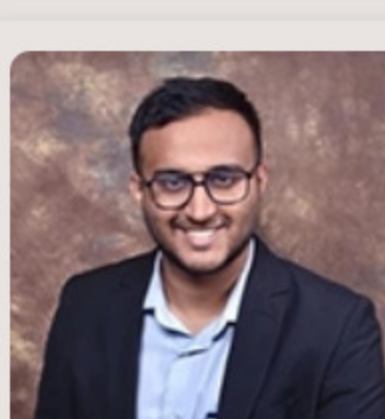

- Conclusion:** Briefly state the significance of your research findings.
