- To provide hands-on experience in curriculum mapping, attainment calculation, and closing the loop for continuous improvement.

- Faculty members will be able to formulate well-structured COs, POs, and PSOs, and align them with institutional goals and national standards (NBA/NAAC).
- Faculties will be equipped to implement modern teaching methodologies that foster active learning, collaboration, and student engagement.
- Faculty will be able to revise or develop course syllabi that embed critical thinking, communication, collaboration, and digital literacy while ensuring outcome alignment.
- Faculties will demonstrate the ability to perform CO-PO mapping, calculate attainment levels, and suggest actionable improvements based on data analysis.
