



Acharya International Design Conference 2026 (AIDC'26)

Author Guidelines

Registration Policy

- Registration by both author and co-authors is mandatory for the paper to be included in the conference proceedings.
- The registration fee includes access as an audience for all conference sessions.
- Payment must be completed through the official conference registration portal.
- Registration confirmation will be shared via email after successful payment.
- After the registration fee is paid, the paper will be forwarded to the review committee for evaluation.

Paper Selection Process

- All submitted papers will undergo review by the technical committee.
- Selection depends on quality, originality, and relevance.
- Review committee's decision will be final.

Publication Details

- Selected papers may be published in journals associated with Wiley, Apple Academic Press, Cambridge Scholar Publication (Scopus indexed).

Publication Policy

- Publication will depend on **review quality and editorial decision**.
- If the paper **does not meet Scopus standards**, it may be **recommended for alternative publication platforms**.
- The conference organizers **reserve the right to change publication platforms** based on requirements.

Paper Submission Rules

- Once paper is submitted to AIDC'26, it **must not be submitted or presented at any other conference**.
- The paper **must not be published elsewhere** before conference proceedings publication.
- Authors must ensure **all co-authors approval** before submission.

Submission Guidelines

- Papers must follow the **conference template and formatting guidelines**.
- Plagiarism should be **below acceptable limits**
(Similarity 10 to 12% and AI content below 30%)
- Authors must mention **proper Citation and references**

Presentation Guidelines

- Paper presentation in conference is mandatory; otherwise, the paper may not be recommended for publication.
- Presentation mode may be online or offline.
- Presentation duration will be communicated in advance.
- Authors must **follow the allocated presentation time**.
- Presentation PPT must be submitted on or before **11th may 2026** to the email **aidc@acharya.ac.in**

Ethical Guidelines

- Authors must ensure that the submitted paper is **original and free from plagiarism**.
- Papers generated fully using **AI tools without proper disclosure** are not permitted.
- Any **ethical misconduct** such as duplicate submission, data fabrication, or falsification will lead to rejection.

Certificate Policy

- Certificates will be issued only to **registered authors** and Co-Authors
- Certificates will be provided for **registered listeners**.
- For offline participants hard copy of certificates will be issued and for online presenters digital certificates will be issued.

Additional Guidelines

- Multiple submissions are allowed; each paper requires separate registration.
- Conference schedule will be shared prior to the event.
- Authors must adhere to submission deadlines.
- All communication will be through official email only.

Refund Policy

- If the registration fee is paid and the paper is not selected, the amount will be refunded.
- Once the author registers and later withdraws from the conference, the registration fee will not be refunded.
- Refunds (if applicable) will be processed within 7-10 working days from the date of Conference.

General Guidelines

- Conference organizers reserve the **right to make necessary changes** in schedule or format.
- Participation implies **acceptance of all conference rules and policies**.
- Authors must maintain **professional conduct** during the conference.
- Authors are required to submit the consent form before the commencement of the conference.

Author Responsibility

- Authors are responsible for **grammar, formatting, and proofreading** of their papers.
- Authors must ensure **correct author names and affiliations** before final submission.
- No changes in **author names or order** will be allowed after final submission.
- No changes in the **title of the paper** are encouraged after the final submission.
