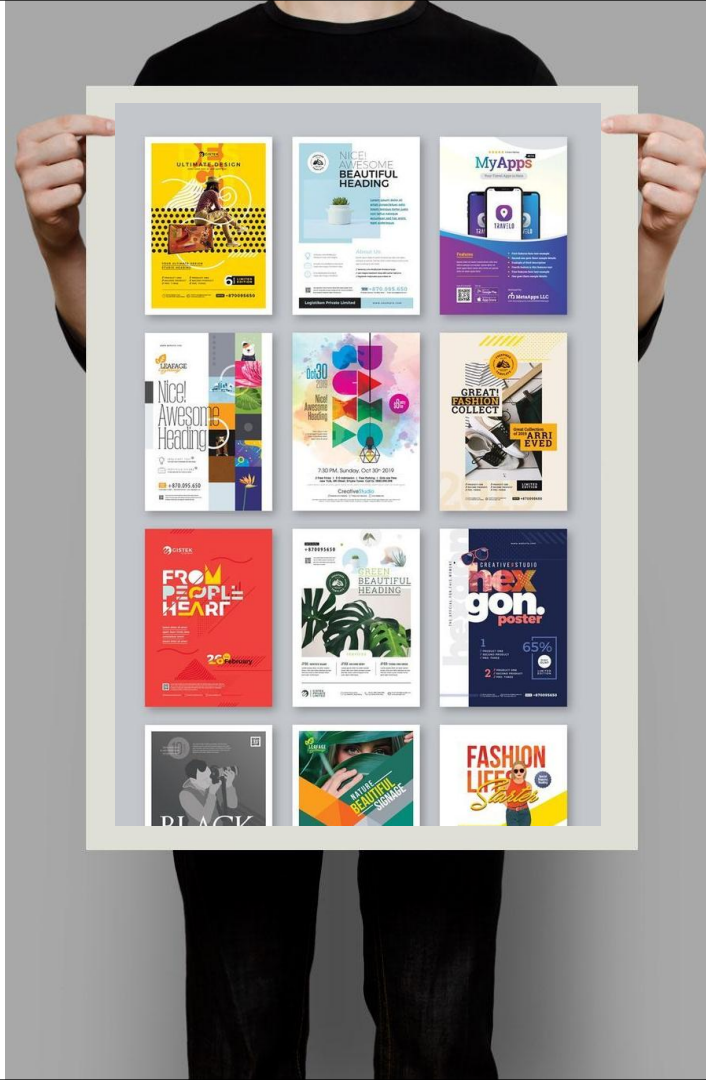


Registration Process:
